

POLICY J

OUT OF STATE STUDENT ENROLLMENT

Beginning with the 2019-2020 school year, any student who resides in a state other than Kansas, who enrolls for the 2019-2020 school year, shall pay to Riverton USD 404 twenty-five (25%) percent of the Kansas base state aid per pupil.

Payment may be made annually or semi-annually and due on or before the thirtieth (30th) day of each semester. Failure to make payment by the due date will result in the dismissal of the student. Payment is non-refundable. A monthly payment schedule may be allowable with District approval. Payments must be current at the beginning of each semester to maintain enrollment.

Beginning in the 2021-2022 school year the out of state tuition shall be fifty (50%) percent of the Kansas base state aid.

The out of state tuition shall be capped at a total amount per family which shall not exceed the amount of tuition equal to two (2) students.

The following exceptions apply to the aforementioned policy:

- A student who has been continuously enrolled in Riverton USD 404 during the 2018-2019 school year
- A student's Parent/Guardian or Grandparent is an employee of Riverton USD 404
- A student is a sibling of a student who has been continuously enrolled in Riverton USD 404 during the 2018-2019 school year.
- Sibling of a Riverton USD 404 graduate.
